School will be dismissed at 3:15 p.m. 5th Grade Car Pickup is at the Front of the Building after the Buses depart.

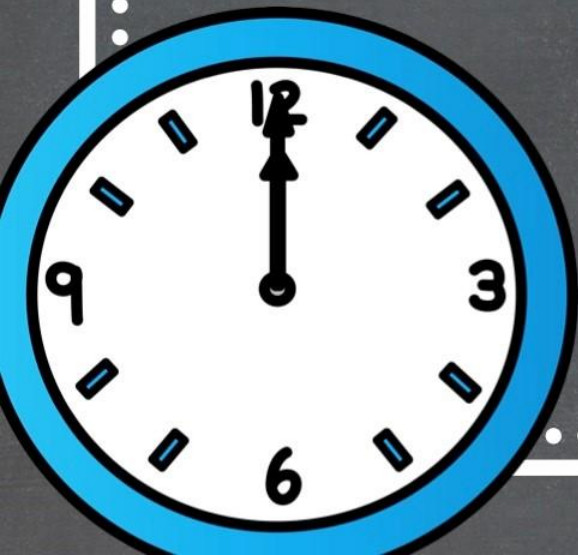
At this time we do not anticipate any changes to be made to the school times.

Breakfast is from 7:45-7:58

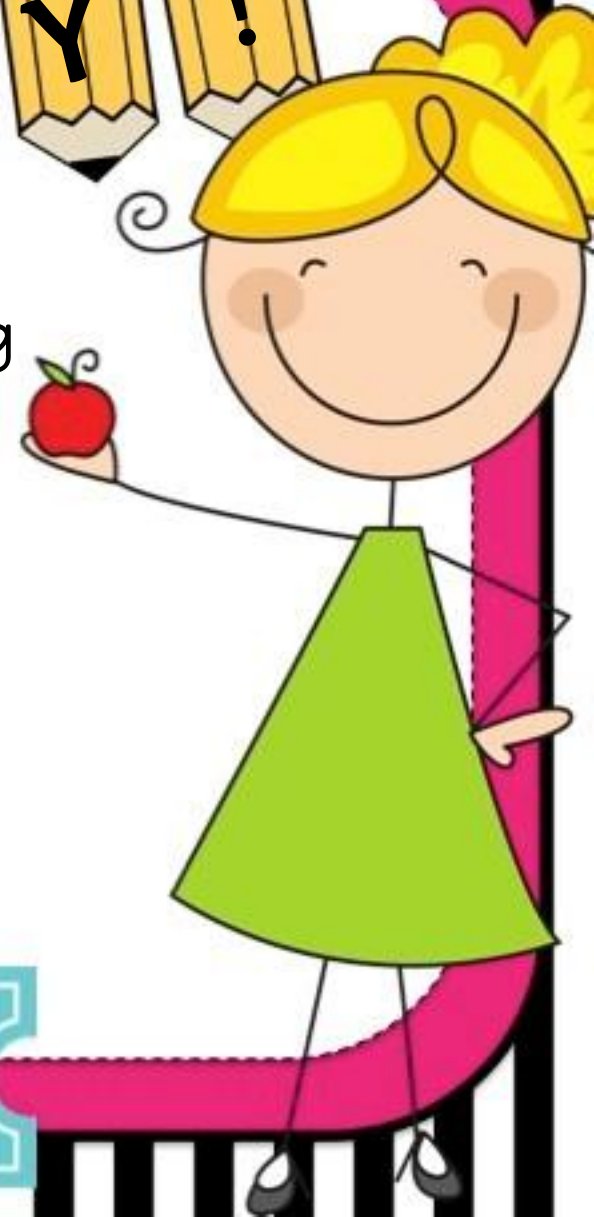
Lunch is from 11:45- 12:30. Depending on the home room teacher, students will eat at 11:45 or 12:05.

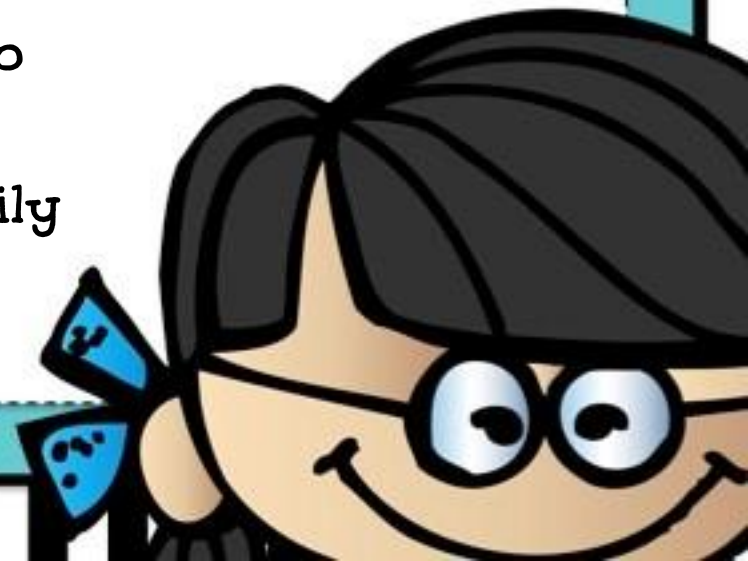
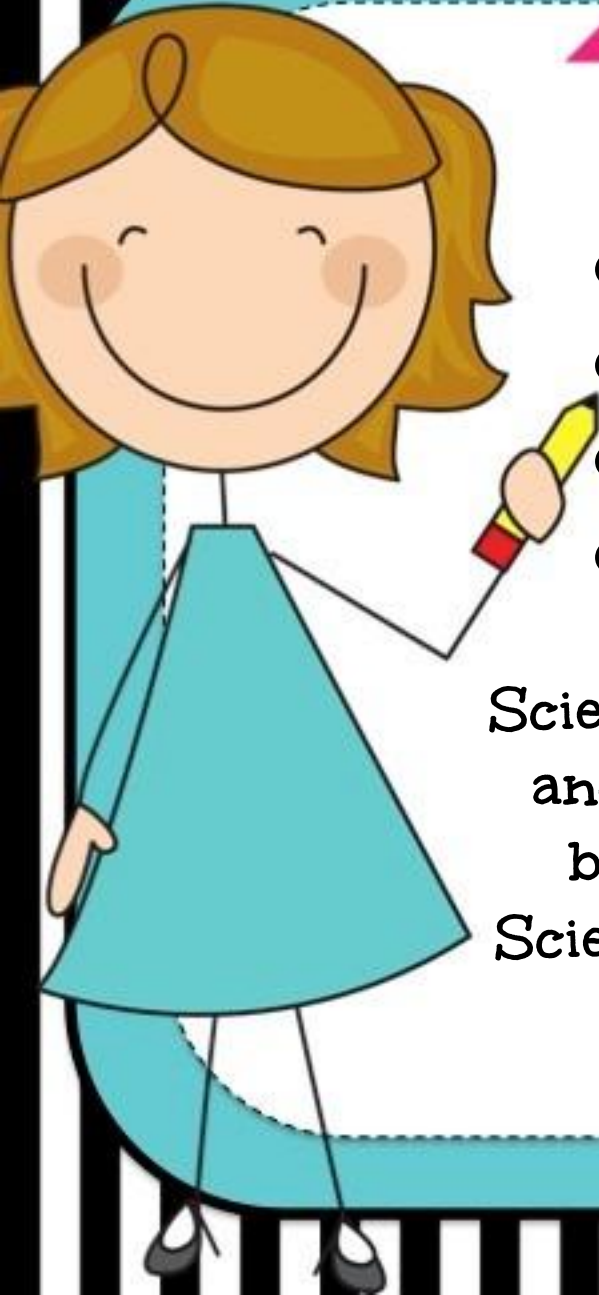

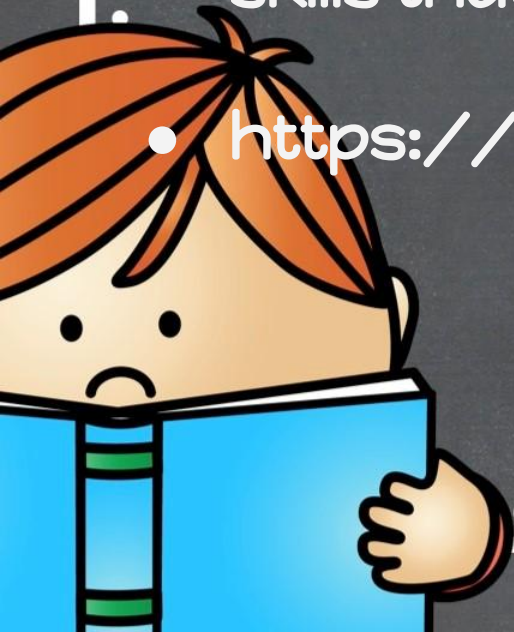
Social Studies is the study of human Society. Where do we come from? Why did our ancestors do this? These are just a few questions we answer in this class.
